

# Changes to Aquatarium Pass – Effective April 1, 2017

The Aquatarium has modified their pass and have changed to a discounted pass system. There will now be a \$5.00 (+ tax) charge per person, children under 4 are free. The pass continues to be valid for up to 5 individuals. However, the restriction limiting the number of adults has been removed. The pass now offers the discounted admission fee for up to 5 persons, regardless of age.

## Borrowing and using the Family Pass is easy!

1. Sign out the Family Pass on an adult card for a one week loan period.
2. Bring your pass to the museum for admission of up to 5 people (Passes do vary: some are max 3 adults, some are max 2 adults, it will say on the pass).
3. Enjoy your visit!

Please remember that, although passes may be placed on hold, there is no guarantee of availability for specific dates. Passes may **not** be reserved for specific dates. You will be notified when the pass becomes available. Limit of **one** pass per household & **no** renewals.
